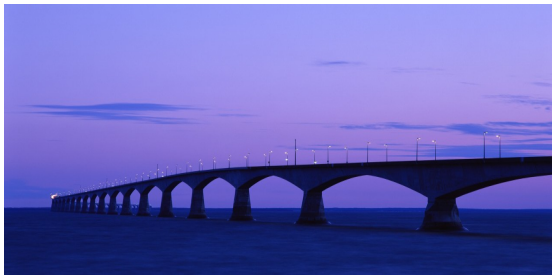

The Eastern Shore Community Services Board (ESCSB) is an organization whose mission is to serve the Eastern Shore's two counties in providing community based mental health, developmental disability services, and substance abuse services as outlined in Chapter 5, Title 37.2-500 of the code of Virginia.

The Eastern Shore Community Services Board currently operates or contracts for a wide variety of services.

Mental Health Services:

- Psychiatric evaluation
- Disability determination
- Forensic evaluations
- Individual, family, marital, and group counseling
- Treatment for children and adolescents
- Psychosocial day activity program
- Housing and community placement assistance
- Community services referrals
- 24 hour emergency services, crisis stabilization, and emergency hospitalization
